## The Nativity Zone

Being a shepherd is a full time job. I really do mean full time; day and night, summer and winter. No holidays, no time to be ill. It's hard work. Dangerous too. Up here on the hills outside Bethlehem there are still wild animals that like nothing better than fresh lamb for their supper. We tend to work together round here. It stops things getting too lonely and means we can watch out for each other. Shepherds spend a long time watching. Most of the time nothing happens, but we watch carefully all the same.



Mostly we watch sheep; sometimes the clouds, sometimes the stars; but mostly sheep. But there's one night I'll never forget: that night we saw something altogether different. It started out normally enough, no wolves, just sky and sheep. Then the sky caught fire.

## The Miracle Zone


The subtitles do not need to be displayed for the text to be narrated. The next slide shows a screen shot from this Zone (but without sound or animation).
